A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to professions and businesses, so as to define the term 'surgery';
- 3 to restate the health care professionals who are authorized to perform surgery; to provide for
- 4 statutory construction; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions relative to professions and businesses, is amended by adding a new Code section
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>43-1-33.</u>
- 12 (a) For purposes of this title except as used in Chapter 50 of this title, the term 'surgery'
- means the structural alteration of the human body by the incision or cutting into of tissue
- 14 for the purpose of diagnostic or therapeutic treatment of conditions or disease processes by
- 15 <u>any instrument causing localized alteration or transposition of live human tissue, but does</u>
- not include procedures for the removal of superficial foreign bodies from the human body,
- punctures, injections, dry needling, acupuncture, or removal of dead tissue. For purposes
- of this subsection, incision shall not mean the scraping or brushing of live tissue.
- 19 (b) No person shall perform surgery in this state unless he or she:
- 20 (1) Is licensed pursuant to Article 2 of Chapter 34 of this title as a physician;
- 21 (2) Is licensed pursuant to Chapter 35 of this title as a podiatrist;
- 22 (3) Is licensed pursuant to Article 2 of Chapter 11 of this title as a dentist;
- 23 (4) Is licensed pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 26 of this title as a nurse practitioner and
- 24 <u>is acting pursuant to physician delegation under protocols reviewed by the Georgia</u>
- 25 <u>Composite Medical Board;</u>

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26	(5) Is licensed pursuant to Article 4 of Chapter 34 of this title as a physician assistant and
27	is acting pursuant to physician delegation under an approved job description;
28	(6) Is licensed pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 26 of this title as a registered professional
29	nurse and recognized by the Georgia Board of Nursing as a certified nurse midwife only
30	in the performance of episiotomies during childbirth; or
31	(7) Is licensed pursuant to Article 9 of Chapter 34 of this title, if such article becomes
32	effective, as a cosmetic laser practitioner acting under agreement with a consulting
33	physician.
34	(c) Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to restrict, limit, alter, or expand the
35	scope of practice, as such scope of practice existed on January 1, 2014, of any health care
36	professional licensed under this title."

SECTION 2.

38 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
