A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Part 1 of Article 7 of Chapter 14 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia 2 Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to foreclosure, so as to prohibit nonjudicial 3 foreclosures on mortgages on real estate when the mortgagor is 65 years of age or older or 4 an adult for whom a guardian or conservator has been appointed; to provide for legislative 5 intent; to revise the definition of the term 'debtor' for certain purposes; to provide for related 6 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

9 Part 1 of Article 7 of Chapter 14 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

10 relating to general provisions relative to foreclosure, is amended by revising Code Section

11 44-14-162.1, relating to 'Debtor' defined, as follows:

12 "44-14-162.1.

13 (a) It is the intent of the General Assembly to prohibit the nonjudicial foreclosure on a

14 mortgage on real estate when the mortgagor is 65 years of age or older or an adult for

15 whom a guardian or conservator has been appointed as provided in Title 29.

16	(b)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, as As used in Code
17	Sections 44-14-162.2 through 44-14-162.4, the term 'debtor' means the grantor of the
18	mortgage, security deed, or other lien contract. In the event the property encumbered by
19	the mortgage, security deed, or lien contract has been transferred or conveyed by the
20	original debtor, the term 'debtor' shall mean the current owner of the property
21	encumbered by the debt, if the identity of such owner has been made known to and
22	acknowledged by the secured creditor prior to the time the secured creditor is required
23	to give notice pursuant to Code Section 44-14-162.2.
24	(2) For purposes of Code Sections 44-14-162.2 through 44-14-162.4, the term 'debtor'
25	shall not include any individual who is:
26	(A) 65 years of age or older; or
27	(B) A ward, as such term is defined in Code Section 29-1-1."
28	SECTION 2.
29	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
