A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to regulation of hospitals and related institutions, so as to provide for educational
- 3 information on influenza disease to residents of assisted living communities; to provide for
- 4 statutory construction; to provide that no cause of action is created; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 regulation of hospitals and related institutions, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 "<u>31-7-21.</u>
- 12 (a) Each assisted living community shall annually provide to each of its residents, no later
- than September 1 of each year, educational information on influenza disease. Such
- information shall include, but is not limited to, the risks associated with influenza disease;
- 15 the availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications of the influenza immunization;
- causes and symptoms of influenza; and the means in which it is spread. Provision of the
- 17 <u>appropriate and current Vaccine Information Statement as provided by the Centers for</u>
- Disease Control and Prevention shall be deemed to comply with this subsection.
- 19 (b) Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to require an assisted living community
- 20 <u>to provide or pay for any vaccination against influenza for its residents.</u>
- 21 (c) No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or damage caused by any act or
- 22 <u>omission resulting from providing, or the lack of providing, educational information</u>
- 23 pursuant to this Code section."

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
