A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-11-62 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 eavesdropping, surveillance, or intercepting communication which invades privacy of
3 another, and divulging private message, so as to provide for limitations regarding the use of
4 electronic monitoring devices; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 16-11-62 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to eavesdropping,
9 surveillance, or intercepting communication which invades privacy of another, and divulging
10 private message, is amended by revising paragraph (7) as follows:

11 "(7) Any person to intentionally and in a clandestine manner place any mobile global
12 positioning system monitoring device or any other electronic monitoring device to track
13 the physical location of an adult person without the consent of such person, and to
14 commit any other acts of a nature similar to those set out in paragraphs (1) through (6)
15 of this Code section which invade the privacy of another."

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
