A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 21-2-540 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 conduct of special primaries and special elections generally, so as to revise provisions
- 3 relating to dates for special elections to present a question to the voters in even-numbered
- 4 years; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 21-2-540 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to conduct of
- 8 special primaries and special elections generally, is amended by revising paragraph (2) of
- 9 subsection (c) as follows:
- 10 "(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a special election to
- present a question to the voters shall be held only on one of the following dates which is
- at least 29 days after the date of the call for the special election:
- 13 (A) In odd-numbered years, any such special election shall only be held on the third
- Tuesday in March or on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November; and
- 15 (B) In even-numbered years, any such special election shall only be held on:

16	(i) The date of and in conjunction with the presidential preference primary if one is
17	held that year third Tuesday in March; provided, however, that in the event that a
18	special election is to be held under this provision in a year in which a presidential
19	preference primary is to be held, then any such special election shall be held on the
20	date of and in conjunction with the presidential preference primary;
21	(ii) The date of the general primary; or
22	(iii) The Tuesday after the first Monday in November."
