# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend an Act making and providing appropriations for the State Fiscal Year beginning 1 2 July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, known as the "General Appropriations Act," Act No. 305, approved May 10, 2021 (Ga. L. 2021, Volume One, Appendix, commencing at page 1 3 4 of 209), to make, provide, and change certain appropriations for the operation of the state 5 government and its departments, boards, bureaus, commissions, institutions, and other agencies, for the university system, common schools, counties, municipalities, and political 6 subdivisions, for all other governmental activities, projects, and undertakings authorized by 7 law, and for all leases, contracts, agreements, and grants authorized by law; to provide for the 8 9 control and administration of funds; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. 10

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### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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### PART I

An Act making and providing appropriations for the State Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021,
and ending June 30, 2022, known as the "General Appropriations Act," Act No. 305,

16 209), is amended by striking everything following the Part I designation up to but not17 including the Part II designation and by substituting in lieu thereof the following:

- 18 "The sums of money hereinafter provided are appropriated for the State Fiscal Year
- beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, as prescribed hereinafter for such fiscal
  year:"
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## PART II

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming lawwithout such approval.

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### PART III

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
