

House Bill 919

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 13 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to general provisions relative to administrative procedure, so as to require state
3 agencies to provide an entrepreneurship impact statement for each rule to be adopted,
4 amended, or repealed; to provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to provide
5 for an effective date; to provide for applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Article 1 of Chapter 13 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
10 general provisions relative to administrative procedure, is amended by adding a new Code
11 section to read as follows:

12 "50-13-4.2.

13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'EIS' means an entrepreneurship impact
14 statement that estimates the direct costs to businesses that have been operating for less than
15 five years.

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16 (b) Each agency shall prepare an EIS for every rule proposed to be adopted, amended, or
17 repealed, other than interpretive rules or general statements of policy. Such EIS shall be
18 provided and transmitted by the agency with the notice required under Code Section
19 50-13-4."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2022, and shall apply to rules adopted, amended,
22 or repealed on or after August 1, 2022.

23 **SECTION 3.**

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
