A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-5-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 murder, malice murder, felony murder, and murder in the second degree, so as to provide for
- 3 the offense of drug-induced homicide; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 16-5-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to murder, malice
- 8 murder, felony murder, and murder in the second degree, is amended by revising subsections
- 9 (d) and (e) and adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 10 "(d) A person commits the offense of murder when, in the commission of a violation of
- subsection (b) or (c) of Code Section 16-13-30, he or she causes the death of another
- human being irrespective of malice, by manufacturing or distributing the Schedule II
- controlled substance fentanyl or any controlled substance containing fentanyl or any
- derivative thereof.

15 (e) A person commits the offense of murder in the second degree when, in the commission

- of cruelty to children in the second degree, he or she causes the death of another human
- being irrespective of malice.
- $\frac{(e)(1)(f)(1)}{(e)(1)}$ A person convicted of the offense of murder shall be punished by death, by
- imprisonment for life without parole, or by imprisonment for life.
- 20 (2) A person convicted of the offense of murder in the second degree shall be punished
- by imprisonment for not less than ten nor more than 30 years."
