A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 exemptions from state sales and use taxes, so as to create a new exemption for admissions
- 3 to major sporting events; to provide a definition; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 4 for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 8 state sales and use taxes, is amended by deleting "or" at the end of paragraph (95), by
- 9 deleting the period and adding "; or" at the end of paragraph (96), and by adding a new
- 10 paragraph to read as follows:

- 11 "(97)(A) Sales of admissions to major sporting events in this state.
- 12 (B) As used in this paragraph, the term 'major sporting event' means the National
- Football League championship game; any semifinal game or championship game of a
- national collegiate tournament; a Major League Baseball, Major League Soccer, or
- National Basketball Association all-star game; or any other major sporting event
- determined by the commissioner of economic development and the state revenue
- commissioner to be expected to generate revenue of at least \$50 million in the host
- locality. The revenue projections for purposes of this paragraph shall include, but not

be limited to, lodging, meals, vehicle rentals, and admissions to tourist attractions."

- SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2016, and shall be applicable to admissions
- 22 purchased on or after January 1, 2017.
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
