A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 5 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 organization of county government, so as to provide that the chief executive officer/county
- 3 commission form of government shall not be authorized for county governing authorities in
- 4 this state; to provide for a definition; to provide for the transition of existing chief executive
- 5 officer/county commission types of county governing authorities; to provide for related
- 6 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 5 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to organization of
- 10 county government, is amended by revising Article 1, which was previously reserved, as
- 11 follows:
- 12 "ARTICLE 1
- 13 36-5-1.
- 14 As used in this article, the term 'chief executive officer/county commission form of
- 15 government' shall mean a form of county government in which there is an official elected
- 16 county wide whose powers include directing the administration of county affairs and
- 17 <u>vetoing matters voted upon by the county commission and a county commission which</u>
- 18 <u>enacts ordinances and resolutions for the governance of the county. This article shall not</u>
- 19 apply to consolidated governments. Reserved.
- 20 <u>36-5-2.</u>
- 21 (a) The chief executive officer/county commission form of government shall not be
- authorized for county governing authorities in this state.

23 (b) Unless otherwise provided by a local Act which is consistent with subsection (a) of this 24 Code section, the governing authority of each county which has an existing chief executive 25 officer/county commission form of government on July 1, 2018, shall continue in existence 26 until the end of the term of office to which the chief executive officer in office on July 1, 27 2018, was elected. At the conclusion of such term of office, the chief executive officer 28 position shall be abolished with the county commission becoming the county governing authority and the duties and responsibilities of the office of chief executive officer being 29 transferred to the chairperson of the county commission." 30

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
