## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 lottery for education, so as to establish the State Gaming Commission; to provide for its
- 3 membership, manner of appointment, terms of office, duties, and responsibilities; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to lottery for
- 8 education, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

## 9 "ARTICLE 4

- 10 <u>50-27-120.</u>
- 11 (a) There is created the State Gaming Commission.
- 12 (b) Such commission shall consist of 15 members. Five members shall be appointed by
- the Governor, five members shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor, and five
- 14 <u>members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The members</u>
- shall be registered electors in this state and shall not have been convicted of any felony
- under the laws of the United States, this state, or any of the several states.
- 17 (c) Of the members appointed by the Governor, the Governor, at the time of the
- 18 <u>appointment of the initial members, shall designate one member to serve a five-year term</u>
- of office, one member to serve a four-year term of office, one member to serve a three-year
- 20 <u>term of office, one member to serve a two-year term of office, and one member to serve</u>
- 21 <u>a one-year term of office.</u>
- 22 (d) Of the members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, at
- 23 the time of the appointment of the initial members, shall designate one member to serve a
- 24 <u>five-year term of office, one member to serve a four-year term of office, one member to</u>

25 <u>serve a three-year term of office, one member to serve a two-year term of office, and one</u>

- 26 <u>member to serve a one-year term of office.</u>
- 27 (e) Of the members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
- 28 Speaker, at the time of the appointment of the initial members, shall designate one member
- 29 <u>to serve a five-year term of office, one member to serve a four-year term of office, one</u>
- 30 member to serve a three-year term of office, one member to serve a two-year term of
- 31 <u>office, and one member to serve a one-year term of office.</u>
- 32 (f) After the initial terms of office, successors to such members shall be appointed by the
- 33 <u>original appointing authority for five-year terms of office.</u>
- 34 (g) The commission shall elect from its number a chairperson and a vice chairperson. The
- 35 <u>commission shall also elect a secretary who need not be a member of the commission.</u>
- 36 (h) The members of the commission shall not receive compensation for their work on the
- 37 <u>commission but, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly, shall be reimbursed for</u>
- 38 <u>actual, reasonable, and necessary expenses incurred while performing their duties as</u>
- members of the commission.
- 40 (i) Vacancies on the commission shall be filled by appointment of the original appointing
- 41 <u>authority for the unexpired term of office.</u>
- 42 (j) The commission shall meet on the call of its chairperson.

- 45 (a) The State Gaming Commission shall undertake a study of the feasibility, practicality,
- 46 and appropriateness of the gaming industry in Georgia to include casino gaming and other
- forms of gaming. The commission shall also study the best use of funds derived from the
- 48 <u>taxation, licensing, and regulation of such activities, including providing financial stability</u>
- 49 <u>to the HOPE scholarship programs.</u>
- 50 (b) Not later than January 10 of each year, the commission shall report to the Governor,
- 51 <u>the Lieutenant Governor, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on its activities</u>
- and any findings and recommendations it may have for legislation.
- 53 (c) Subject to appropriation by the General Assembly, the commission shall be authorized
- 54 to hire staff members and experts in the area of gaming to assist the commission in its
- 55 study."
