A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 48-8-200 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
definitions relative to water and sewer projects and costs tax, so as to change a definition; to
provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- **SECTION 1.** 6 7 Code Section 48-8-200 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions 8 relative to water and sewer projects and costs tax, is amended by revising paragraph (3) as 9 follows: 10 "(3) 'Municipality' means a municipality in which the average waste-water flow of such 11 municipality, or when combined with the waste-water flow received from waste-water 12 systems owned by other governments located outside of its corporate limits, is not less than 85 million gallons per day or a municipality that has an intergovernmental 13 14 agreement pursuant to Article IX, Section III, Paragraph I of the Georgia Constitution 15 providing for the discharge of waste-water from the municipal sewer system within such 16 municipality's corporate boundaries to the sewer system of a municipality that has an average combined waste-water flow of not less than 85 million gallons per day." 17 **SECTION 2.** 18 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law 20 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
