A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-10-32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 attempted murder or threatening of witness in official proceedings, so as to provide for 3 offense of attempted murder where a person shoots a law enforcement officer; to provide for 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.
Code Section 16-10-32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to attempted
murder or threatening of witness in official proceedings, is amended by revising subsection
(a) as follows:
"(a) Any person who attempts to kill another person with intent to:
(1) Prevent the attendance or testimony of any person in an official proceeding;
(2) Prevent the production of a record, document, or other object, in an official
proceeding; or
(3) Prevent the communication by any person to a law enforcement officer, prosecuting
attorney, or judge of this state of information relating to the commission or possible

- 16 commission of a criminal offense or a violation of conditions of probation, parole, or
- 17 release pending judicial proceedings<u>; or</u>
- 18 (4) Prevent any law enforcement officer from performing his or her duties pursuant to
- 19 Article 6 of Chapter 8 of Title 42 by shooting a gun at and causing physical injury to such
- 20 <u>law enforcement officer</u>
- shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment
- 22 for not less than ten nor more than 20 years."

- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
