A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 43-34-242 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 definitions relative to the "Georgia Cosmetic Laser Services Act," so as to revise a definition;
- 3 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Code Section 43-34-242 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
- 7 relative to the "Georgia Cosmetic Laser Services Act," is amended by revising paragraph (5)
- 8 as follows:
- 9 "(5) 'Cosmetic laser services' means nonablative elective cosmetic light based skin care,
- photo rejuvenation, or hair removal using lasers or pulsed light devices approved by the
- 11 United States Food and Drug Administration for noninvasive procedures and includes
- 12 <u>energy based medical procedures using an ultrasound, cryolipolysis, microwave, or radio</u>
- frequency device that is not expected or intended to remove, burn, or vaporize the live
- epidermal surface of the skin, but may damage underlying tissue, if used inappropriately.
- Such services and the provision thereof shall not be considered to be the practice of
- 16 medicine."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
