A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to the sales tax for educational purposes, so as to provide for equitable,
- 3 civil and criminal enforcement actions to be brought in superior court; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to the sales tax for educational purposes, is amended by adding a new Code section
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>48-8-145.</u>
- 11 The superior courts of this state shall have jurisdiction to enforce compliance with the
- provisions of this part, including the power to grant injunctions or other equitable relief.
- 13 <u>In addition to any action that may be brought by any person or entity, the Attorney General</u>
- shall have authority to bring enforcement actions, either civil or criminal, in his or her
- discretion as may be appropriate to enforce compliance with this part."

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
