2 Chief Executive Officer of the Murphy-Harpst Children's Centers; and for other purposes.

18 Affiliate of AHA, and Senior Vice President for Major and Planned Gifts; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Troutman and his wife, Angie, are the proud and dedicated parents of two
20 wonderful daughters; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
22 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

24 the members of this body commend Mr. Charles Troutman for his efficient, effective, and
25 dedicated public service to the State of Georgia, congratulate him upon the grand occasion
