Congratulating the University of Georgia Women's Soccer team for an outstanding 2023
 season; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the University of Georgia Women's Soccer team has established and maintained
a proud tradition of excellence with equal emphases on character and academics; and

5 WHEREAS, this superlative team has completed another triumphant season of soccer
6 competition by posting an outstanding record of 13 wins, four losses, and six ties and a No.
7 13 national ranking, the highest among all SEC programs and the highest in school history;

9 WHEREAS, excellent play, superior teamwork, and extraordinary resilience made this team
10 a spectacular one to observe throughout the season, and as a fitting finale to its remarkable
11 2023 conference campaign, the team captured the first SEC East Division and SEC Soccer
12 Tournament championships in program history; and

WHEREAS, the team advanced to the NCAA Tournament Third Round for only the secondtime in program history, earning NCAA Tournament victories over Liberty and Iowa,

securing a program-record five postseason victories between the SEC and NCAATournaments; and

WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding athletic ability, dedication, hard work, and unity of purpose and spirit of each member of the team; its superb offensive and defensive talents; and the astute direction of Head Coach Keidane McAlpine who surpassed 200 career victories following Georgia's win at Missouri on September 24 and the program surpassed 300 victories with the SEC Tournament championship win; and

23 WHEREAS, this all-star team included: graduate midfielder Croix Bethune, who became the fifth All-American in program history, earning a place on the United Soccer Coaches 24 25 All-America Second Team, and was also named to the All-Southeast Region Team, to the 26 SEC All-Tournament Team, and as SEC Tournament MVP; redshirt freshman midfielder 27 Summer Denigan, who was named SEC Co-Freshman of the Year and was the only freshman 28 named to the All-Southeast Region Team; redshirt senior midfielder Nicole Vernis, senior 29 defender Madison Haugen, junior defender Jessie Dunn, and sophomore defender Cate 30 Hardin, all of whom were named to College Sports Communicators Academic All-District 31 Team; and graduate Mallie McKenzie, who set a new program record for most career 32 appearances, finishing her Bulldog career with 98 matches played; and

WHEREAS, Croix Bethune was further selected third overall by Washington Spirit in the
NWSL Draft, the highest draft pick in program history; and

WHEREAS, this magnificent team performed with precision during the season and earned
its well-deserved reputation for high standards of athletic achievement, the quality of its play,
and the stiff competition it presented to its opponents.
