A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Gregory "Greg" Stalls, Sr., and dedicating a bridge in his memory;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Gregory "Greg" Stalls, Sr. was born in Atlanta, Georgia, a beloved son of
4 Bennie J. Kennedy and Alice Esther Stalls; and

5 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Stalls was an active member of New
6 Fellowship Praise Baptist Church; and

7 WHEREAS, his advocacy for Atlanta's youth was evidenced dramatically by his career with
8 the city's Youth Services Division, membership with Economic Opportunity Atlanta, and
9 directorship of the Southern Area Youth Council; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Stalls gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep
11 concern for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he
12 demonstrated to his family and friends were admired by others; and

13 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
14 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
15 made this world a better place in which to live; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
17 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on State Route 166/Langford Parkway over the
20 I-75/I-85/Downtown Connector in Fulton County is dedicated as the Gregory Stalls, Sr.,
21 Memorial Bridge.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
23 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Gregory Stalls, Sr., Memorial
24 Bridge.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
27 family of Mr. Gregory "Greg" Stalls, Sr., and to the Department of Transportation.
