A RESOLUTION

- 1 Compensating Robert-Charles: Dukes; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, in 2004, Robert-Charles: Dukes was arrested and incarcerated in DeKalb
- 3 County, Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was held in jail for 120 days prior to his release on March 16, 2005; and
- 5 WHEREAS, on March 16, 2005, DeKalb Superior Court Judge Anne Workman signed an
- 6 order of nolle prosequi in favor of Mr. Dukes and he was released for lack of evidence; and
- 7 WHEREAS, as a result of the actions of the state district attorney and superior court,
- 8 Robert-Charles: Dukes has suffered loss in the amount of \$75,000.00; and
- 9 WHEREAS, such loss occurred through no fault or negligence on the part of Robert-Charles:
- 10 Dukes, and it is only fitting and proper that he be compensated for his loss.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 12 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the Department of Law is authorized and directed to pay
- 13 the sum of \$75,000.00 to Robert-Charles: Dukes as compensation as provided above. Said
- sum shall be paid from funds appropriated to or available to said department and shall be in
- 15 full and complete satisfaction of all claims against the state arising out of said occurrence.
