- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated advocates
- 3 with the tragic passing of Dawn Alford, who lost her life unexpectedly on July 22, 2019, at
- 4 the age of 41; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Dawn Alford served as the public policy director and as an educator at the state
- 6 capitol building for the Georgia Council on Developmental Disabilities; and
- 7 WHEREAS, she was an extraordinary advocate for people with disabilities and fought so that
- 8 all Georgians with disabilities could live full and meaningful lives in the community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dawn Alford advocated for the promise upheld by the United States Supreme
- 10 Court's Olmstead decision, which determined that people with disabilities have the right to
- 11 live in their communities rather than in nursing homes or institutions; and
- 12 WHEREAS, born on July 27, 1977, in Carroll County, Georgia, she excelled in her early
- 13 academics, graduating as valedictorian of Temple High School before graduating magna cum
- 14 laude from Georgia Tech with a degree in chemical engineering; and
- 15 WHEREAS, after graduation, Dawn Alford began to visit nursing homes and build
- 16 relationships with people while advocating for them to return to the community; she spent
- 17 her remaining years tirelessly advocating at the state capitol building, creating contacts and
- 18 friendships throughout state government and the advocacy community; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Dawn Alford will long be remembered for having lived a joyful life of faith and
- 20 love for God, her friends, her family, and her fellow advocates.
