A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of February 5-9, 2018, as National School Counseling Week at the
2 state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, school counselors are employed in public and private schools to help students
4 reach their full potential; and

5 WHEREAS, school counselors are actively committed to helping students explore their
6 abilities, strengths, interests, and talents as these traits relate to career awareness and
7 development; and

8 WHEREAS, school counselors help parents focus on ways to further the educational,
9 personal, and social growth of their children; and

10 WHEREAS, school counselors work with teachers and other educators to help students
11 explore their potential and set realistic goals; and

12 WHEREAS, school counselors seek to identify and utilize community resources that can
13 enhance and complement comprehensive school counseling programs and help students
14 become productive members of society; and

15 WHEREAS, comprehensive developmental school counseling programs are considered an
16 integral part of the educational process and enable all students to achieve success in school;

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to recognize the contributions of school
19 counselors to the education and welfare of young people in this state.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body recognize the week of February 5-9, 2018, as National School

22 Counseling Week and commend Georgia's dedicated school counselors for their commitment
23 to the students of this state.
