- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Dr. Julius S. Scott Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Dr. Julius S. Scott Jr. on August 1, 2019; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Julius S. Scott Jr. was born on February 26, 1925, in Houston, Texas, a beloved  
5 son of Julius S. Sr. and Bertha Bell Scott; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott was a tireless servant to the countless communities, organizations, and  
7 institutions to which he dedicated himself, holding numerous leadership roles throughout his  
8 life, and was a world-traveled man of culture and philanthropy; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Dr. Scott was an active member of St. Andrew  
10 By-the-Sea United Methodist Church; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Ianthia L. Harrell, and was  
12 blessed with three remarkable children, Julius III, David, and Lamar; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
14 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
15 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
17 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
18 made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Dr. Julius S. Scott Jr. will long be  
20 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who  
21 had the great fortune of knowing him.
