## A RESOLUTION

- 14 adolescents, is president of the American Medical Association (AMA), the highly recognized
- 15 and largest physician association in the United States, with 250,000 members; and

three of the largest medical associations in the United States, comprising nearly 476,000
physicians, an accomplishment in which Georgia can take immense pride.
