## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Madison Jennings; and for other purposes.
  
- 2 WHEREAS, Madison Jennings, a Georgia native is soon to begin her graduate studies at  
3 Oxford University as a Rhodes Scholar; and
  
- 4 WHEREAS, she is a graduate of the Chatham County Public School System and graduated  
5 from the Savannah Arts Academy with a major in dance, and she also participated in the  
6 Governors Honors Program; and
  
- 7 WHEREAS, a senior at Agnes Scott College, she was named one of just 32 American 2024  
8 Rhodes Scholars, one of the most prestigious international scholarships; and
  
- 9 WHEREAS, she recently completed an internship at the Carter Center, where she worked  
10 on advancing the Rule of Law program activities in Liberia and the State of Georgia, which  
11 seek to develop capacity-building programs for civil society partners and identify support for  
12 policing alternatives, respectively; and
  
- 13 WHEREAS, she serves as the president of Agnes Scott's pre-law society and is an alumna  
14 of the Duke Prelaw Fellowship; and

15 WHEREAS, she has also completed policy-focused internships at the Metro Atlanta  
16 Chamber of Commerce and CARE USA; and

17 WHEREAS, using a grant awarded to her, she founded PopUp Library for Peace, a local  
18 library with the goal of combating downwards literacy trends due to the COVID-19  
19 pandemic; and

20 WHEREAS, at Oxford, she aims to build upon these experiences and graduate with a Master  
21 of Public Policy and a Master of Science in Public Policy Research; and

22 WHEREAS, upon her return to the United States, she aspires to be a policy director and use  
23 these experiences to advance civil society initiatives.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
25 the members of this body recognize and commend the extensive list of achievements earned  
26 by Madison Jennings and her hard work, drive, and determination; and acknowledge that her  
27 status as a Rhodes Scholar and ambitious study and career plans bring pride to the State of  
28 Georgia.
