A RESOLUTION

Honoring several cities upon their designation as Georgia PlanFirst communities; and for

WHEREAS, the year 2024 marks the 34th anniversary of the implementation of the Georgia

interest in protecting and preserving the natural resources, the environment, and the vital
areas of the state as well as serves these interests through coordinated and comprehensive

WHEREAS, this legislative body is justly proud to honor the City of Bainbridge, the City of Cornelia, the City of Hawkinsville, the City of Marietta, and the City of Perry for their outstanding and commendable community planning efforts and accomplishments, which

25 hereby designate them as Georgia PlanFirst communities; and

WHEREAS, it is the sense of this legislative body that those local governments that enhance the well-being and vitality of their communities and have shown a long and sustained commitment to excellence in planning and plan implementation certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that the members of this body honor the City of Bainbridge, the City of Cornelia, the City of Hawkinsville, the City of Marietta, and the City of Perry for their many community planning accomplishments in conjunction with the 34th anniversary of the Georgia Planning Act.
