- 1 Honoring the life and memory of the Honorable Rodney Mims Cook, Sr.; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
- 4 with the passing of the Honorable Rodney Mims Cook, Sr., on January 13, 2013; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a native of Atlanta, Mr. Cook was the beloved son of James Leslie and Bess
- 6 Mims Cook; he attended Washington and Lee University and graduated valedictorian and
- 7 summa cum laude with a Bachelor of Arts degree and memberships in ODK and Phi Beta
- 8 Kappa; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
- 10 States Navy, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans as a Lieutenant in
- 11 the Pacific Theater during World War II; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Cook was united in love and marriage to Lane Young and was blessed with
- 13 three remarkable children, Jody Cook, Laura Cook, and Rodney Mims Cook, Jr., and three
- wonderful grandchildren, English and Alexandra Mims Cook and Walker Mims Marshall;

- 16 WHEREAS, he was a seventh generation Georgia public figure who served for over 20 years
- 17 as an Atlanta alderman and member of the Georgia House of Representatives, serving on the
- 18 Appropriations, Ways and Means, and Industry committees as well as the Joint Senate-House
- 19 Committee on Computerized Criminal Records; and
- 20 WHEREAS, one of the first Republican officials elected in Georgia since Reconstruction,
- 21 Mr. Cook wrote Atlanta legislation pertaining to civil rights, zoning, urban renewal, the
- 22 Atlanta airport, the Interstate Highway System, Underground Atlanta, and the Atlanta
- 23 Stadium Authority; and

24 WHEREAS, he inspired many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern for his

- 25 fellow citizens, advocating for the removal of Peyton Wall, voting to seat the legally elected
- 26 Julian Bond despite his anti-Vietnam War position, championing the careers of Paul
- 27 Coverdell and Newt Gingrich, and acting as a patron in the Atlanta community; and
- 28 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Cook will long be remembered for his
- 29 myriad contributions to Atlanta and Georgia, and this father, friend, and public servant will
- 30 be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

- 32 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of the Honorable Rodney
