## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 15, 2024, as Georgia Federation of Democratic Women in Blue Day  
2 at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Federation of Democratic Women is the official Georgia chapter  
4 of the National Federation of Democratic Women (NFDW); and

5 WHEREAS, founded in 1971, the NFDW is the Democratic National Committee's (DNC)  
6 official women's organization and receives one seat on the DNC Executive Committee and  
7 three seats on the DNC; and

8 WHEREAS, the Democratic Party and women share common values and priorities, including  
9 supporting families, protecting the country, and advancing the issues that matter most to  
10 women of all ages and ethnicities; and

11 WHEREAS, the Georgia Federation of Democratic Women engages women in the  
12 democratic process through a wide array of political activities, including providing its  
13 members with substantive information, discussion, and action items, along with opportunities  
14 to hear from and interact with party leaders; and

15 WHEREAS, the Georgia Federation of Democratic Women believes in the enduring power  
16 of women; works to ensure that our rights and privileges are protected and that our voices  
17 are never silenced; and strives to provide an inclusive and supportive environment for all  
18 women regardless of race, religion, or social background, empowering women to be active  
19 and engaged in advancing the issues that matter most; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
21 extraordinary organization be appropriately recognized by a day of advocacy.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
23 the members of this body recognize February 15, 2024, as Georgia Federation of Democratic  
24 Women in Blue Day at the state capitol.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
27 public and the press.
