- 1 Honoring the life of Mr. James Oscar Hardigree, Jr., and dedicating a road in his memory;
- 2 and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
- 4 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
- 5 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. James Oscar Hardigree, Jr., demonstrated a deep personal commitment to
- 7 protecting democracy and a willingness to sacrifice his own personal safety and comfort to
- 8 ensure the well-being of his fellow man; and
- 9 WHEREAS, this brave man served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty,
- attaining the rank of Technician Fifth Grade (T/5) and valiantly protecting the people and
- 11 ideals of the United States during World War II; and
- 12 WHEREAS, a native of Oconee County, Georgia, T/5 Hardigree made the ultimate sacrifice
- 13 for this nation after he was mortally wounded during combat in Italy on May 31, 1944; and
- 14 WHEREAS, T/5 Hardigree demonstrated selfless service to this nation, and his unyielding
- 15 commitment was recognized with a Purple Heart; and
- 16 WHEREAS, T/5 Hardigree embodied the spirit of service, willing to find meaning in
- something greater than himself, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable
- and distinguished Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his memory.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 20 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 15 from mile marker 6 to mile
- 21 marker 8 in Oconee County is dedicated as the T/5 James Oscar Hardigree, Jr., U.S. Army
- 22 WWII Memorial Highway.
