## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia State University and recognizing February 3, 2016, as Georgia State  
2 University Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Georgia State University, founded in 1913, is a premier urban research  
4 university focused on research, service, and advanced educational opportunities for more  
5 than 50,000 students; and

6 WHEREAS, Georgia State University celebrates the successful consolidation with Georgia  
7 Perimeter College this year, becoming the largest public university in Georgia and one of the  
8 largest in the country; and

9 WHEREAS, Georgia State University, a national leader in graduating students from widely  
10 diverse backgrounds, has been named the 5th "most innovative" university by *U.S. News and*  
11 *World Report*; and

12 WHEREAS, Georgia State University has achieved this prestigious distinction by a  
13 combination of strategic investment of well-trained advisers and predictive analytics to  
14 optimize student success and increase graduation rates by 22 percentage points in the last  
15 decade, one of the most dramatic increases in the country; and

16 WHEREAS, Georgia State University continues its important role in addressing critical  
17 quality of life issues, such as cancer, obesity, inflammation, vaccination, and public health,  
18 with a research portfolio that topped \$101 million and an increase in federal sponsorship  
19 by 21 percent, all achieved just 20 years after being designated a research institution; and

20 WHEREAS, Georgia State University continues to expand its footprint in the downtown  
21 Atlanta area with the construction of new residential housing, a second research building, and  
22 plans to further develop a south campus just a few short blocks from the state capitol; and

23 WHEREAS, Georgia State University's student-athletes have achieved great success in sports  
24 and in the classroom, competing in the National Collegiate Athletic Association basketball  
25 tournament, the AutoNation Cure Bowl in football, winning two conference championship  
26 titles, participating in the American Volleyball Coaches Association Beach Volleyball  
27 National Championship, and leading the Sun Belt Conference in graduation success rate; and

28 WHEREAS, Georgia State University is a powerful force for progress in Georgia, educating  
29 students and advancing research while revitalizing Atlanta through a strong commitment to  
30 the community; and

31 WHEREAS, this body counts 19 members who have graduated from this fine institution and  
32 numerous alums and students who work in the capitol; and

33 WHEREAS, the President, students, faculty, and alumni of this fine institution are welcomed  
34 to the Gold Dome for Georgia State University Day at the state capitol.

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
36 the members of this body commend Georgia State University on more than a century of  
37 providing exemplary education and recognize February 3, 2016, as Georgia State University  
38 Day at the state capitol.
