- 17 WHEREAS, As a served as a Dooly County commissioner for 26 years, with eight of those

- 19 WHEREAS, he served his community in various capacities, including Dooly Medical Center
- 20 Hospital Authority chairperson, Middle Georgia Technical College board member, and
