3 WHEREAS, in 1999, Representative Nikki T. Randall became the first African American
4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Legislative Women's Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Legislative Women's
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Rosalind Sconiers is a passionate humanitarian committed to aiding the
11 underserved, including homeless individuals, veterans, low-income families, senior citizens,
12 and the youth community; and

13 WHEREAS, as the founder and CEO of Sconiers Homeless Preventive Inc., a 501(c)(3)
14 grassroots organization established in 2004, Rosalind Sconiers has supported more than
15 30,000 individuals with the aid of community partners and stakeholders; and

16 WHEREAS, through her advocacy for human and civil rights, leadership in the nonprofit
17 community, and service in several small business collaboratives, Rosalind has established
18 a glowing reputation of renown throughout the State of Georgia; and

19 WHEREAS, her contributions have been recognized both locally and internationally, leading
20 to her receipt of several awards and honors throughout her years of service; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
22 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body congratulate and commend Rosalind Sconiers for receiving the
25 2024 Yellow Rose Nikki T. Randall Servant Leader Award and extend best wishes for her
