3 WHEREAS, the Georgia State University Panthers football team, in just its eighth season of

4 play, earned its first bowl game victory with a 27-17 win over Western Kentucky University

in the AutoNation Cure Bowl in Orlando, Florida; and 5

6 WHEREAS, the Panthers, led by first-year head coach Shawn Elliott, recorded their first 7 winning season as a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) program with a new school record of

8 seven victories; and

9 WHEREAS, the team won five road games during the season, tied for second in the nation; 10 and

11 WHEREAS, the Georgia State defense set school records for fewest points allowed per

12 game, fewest rushing yards allowed per game, fewest yards per rushing attempt, and most

- 14 WHEREAS, the Georgia State offense set school records for highest completion percentage
- 15 and fewest interceptions in a season, as well as most yards in a single game; and
- 16 WHEREAS, nine Georgia State student-athletes earned All-Sun Belt Conference recognition,
- 17 led by first team all-conference selection Penny Hart; and
- WHEREAS, GSU student-athletes Chandon Sullivan, Gabe Mobley, and Julien Laurent were 18
- 19 named Academic All-District by the College Sports Information Directors of America; and
- Sullivan went on to become Georgia State's first football Academic All-American, as well 20
- as a finalist for the prestigious William V. Campbell Trophy; and 21
