## A RESOLUTION

5 educational organization whose first chapter was established in Johnson City, Tennessee, in  
6 1942; and

9 private business schools; and

10 WHEREAS, FBLA-PBL is a professional business organization dedicated to bringing  
11 business and education together in a positive working relationship through innovative
