## A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Carrington Manous, Miss Cobb County's Teen 2024; and

3 WHEREAS, a tenth grade honors student at Woodward Academy, Carrington Manous was  
4 crowned last year as Miss Cobb County's Teen 2024; and

5 WHEREAS, she will go on to participate in the Miss Georgia's Teen competition in June  
6 2024, the winner of which will represent the State of Georgia and compete for the title of  
7 Miss America's Teen; and

8 WHEREAS, she has established the nonprofit organization Carrington Cares to provide  
9 individuals with the resources needed to identify, manage, and master their learning  
10 differences as well as to dispel myths associated with dyslexia; and

11 WHEREAS, through her social impact initiative Carrington Cares #DecodeDsylexia,  
12 Carrington works to educate families and students in Georgia and around the world about  
13 dyslexia; and

14 WHEREAS, she worked with members of the Georgia General Assembly to support Senate  
15 Bill 48, which passed and provided \$3.5 million in funding to enable students in kindergarten  
16 through third grade to have access to free dyslexia testing; and

17 WHEREAS, she further serves as a member of the Teen Board for the International Dyslexia  
18 Association-GA as well as a member of the Buckhead Atlanta Chapter of Jack and Jill of  
19 America Inc.; and

20 WHEREAS, in her spare time, she can be found dancing competitively with her dance  
21 company A.R.E.A, participating in her school's debate team, or riding her bike around the  
22 metro Atlanta area with her family; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
24 remarkable and distinguished young Georgian be appropriately recognized.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
26 the members of this body congratulate Carrington Manous upon her win as Miss Cobb
