- 19 Bachelor of Arts in speech and theater and continues her involvement today as a member of
- 20 the board of trustees, and she later earned a Doctor of Philosophy and human letters degree
- 21 from Trinity International University; and
- WHEREAS, she is the news brand manager and public affairs director for Audacy Atlanta,
- 23 formerly Entercom and CBS Radio Atlanta, and, in that role, supervises the news and traffic
- 24 reporters, and she is also the morning news anchor for V103 and WAOK and the host of the
- 25 public affairs program "Atlanta Up Close with Dr. Maria Boynton" which is broadcast and
- streamed on V103, WAOK, Star 94.1, and 92.9 The Game; and
- 27 WHEREAS, she has dedicated numerous hours to community service, along with advocating
- 28 for financial assistance for students at Historically Black Colleges and Universities, and is
- 29 also a member of the National Kidney Foundation Atlanta Advisory Board; and
