A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the bicentennial of Early County; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Early County was created in 1818 and was named for Peter Early who served
- 3 as a member of Congress from Georgia, a judge, a member of the Georgia General
- 4 Assembly, and as the 28th Governor of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, at the time of its creation, Early County encompassed all of southwest Georgia
- 6 and covered about 3,770 square miles; and
- 7 WHEREAS, over time, ten other counties were created from the original boundaries of Early
- 8 County, reducing it to its current 511.2 square miles; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the earliest known inhabitants of the area were the Lower Creek Indians who
- 10 ceded the area to the United States by treaty in 1818 following the removal of most of the
- 11 Native American populations from Georgia by General Andrew Jackson in 1817; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the first settlement in the area was a 100 square foot fort named Fort Gaines,
- 13 after General Edmund Pendleton Gaines; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Early County is the site of the Kolomoki Mounds, a park preserving major
- earthworks built by indigenous peoples of the Woodland culture more than 1,700 years ago
- and is one of the largest mound complexes in the United States and the largest in Georgia,
- including burial and ceremonial mounds which express the ancient people's cosmology, as
- 18 the mounds are aligned with the sun at the spring equinox and summer solstice; and
- 19 WHEREAS, when Baker County was created from Early County in 1825, the citizens of
- 20 Early County had to establish a new county seat which they placed in a town that is known
- 21 today as Blakely, which was incorporated in 1870 and was named after Captain Johnston
- 22 Blakeley who was lost with the crew of the United States sloop-of-war Wasp; and

23 WHEREAS, during the Civil War, David S. Johnston's Southern Confederate Navy Yard was

- 24 established at Saffold on the Chattahoochee River in the southern part of the county and
- 25 produced one gunboat, the CSS Chattahoochee, which was delivered in 1862, although two
- other gunboats were under construction when the war ended; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Early County's economy is primarily agricultural with large holdings in peanuts,
- 28 cotton, beef cattle, and timber; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Early County has three public schools and one private school with Bainbridge
- 30 State College holding classes at the high school and Albany Technical College operating a
- 31 satellite campus in the county; and
- WHEREAS, Early County is engaging in a one-year celebration of its bicentennial in 2018
- 33 to reflect on its past, appreciate its present, and set goals for its future; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Early County is dedicated to the achievement, accomplishment, and moving
- 35 forward to benefit all of its citizens;
- 36 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the members of this body to recognize and
- 37 congratulate the citizens of Early County on their achievements and accomplishments as they
- 38 celebrate Early County's bicentennial.
- 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 40 the members of this body recognized and commend the citizens of Early County on the
- 41 occasion of the bicentennial of Early County and extend to them the most sincere best wishes
- 42 for continued health and happiness.
- 43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Early
- 45 County and the press and public.
