A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 9, 2020, as STEM Advocacy Day at the state capitol and commending
2 the WiredCats Robotics Team; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
4 important objective of the General Assembly; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the WiredCats Robotics Team is composed of students from The Westminster
6 Schools and ambassadors of the FIRST robotics community (FRC); and
- 7 WHEREAS, last year for the FRC 2019 Game "Destination: Deep Space," the team created
8 a robot that used an elevator to place disks and shoot balls; and
- 9 WHEREAS, for the FRC 2020 Game "Infinite Recharge," the team will make a flywheel
10 robot that can shoot balls into a goal and hang from a bar; and
- 11 WHEREAS, during the build season, the WiredCats Robotics Team designs, fabricates,
12 codes, and tests a 125 pound robot that can play each year's unique game within the span of
13 around ten weeks; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in recognition of such remarkable contributions to STEM education in Georgia,
15 it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to honor the extraordinary accomplishments
16 of the WiredCats Robotics Team.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body recognize March 9, 2020, as STEM Advocacy Day at the state
19 capitol and commend the WiredCats Robotics Team.
