A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Bobby Cox for his induction into the National Baseball Hall of Fame and
- 2 inviting Mr. Cox to be recognized by the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Bobby Cox was born on May 21, 1941, and he is a former Major League
- 4 Baseball third baseman and manager; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Cox was unanimously elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame by the
- 6 Veterans Committee, and his induction ceremony will be held on July 27, 2014, in
- 7 Cooperstown, New York; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Cox began his managerial career in the Yankees farm system in 1971; and
- 9 WHEREAS, between managerial stints with Toronto and his second with Atlanta, Mr. Cox
- served as Braves general manager from October, 1985, through October, 1990; in that role,
- 11 he oversaw the groundwork for Atlanta's subsequent success by accumulating talented
- 12 players, including Tom Glavine, Steve Avery, Pete Smith, and David Justice; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Cox is responsible for elevating the Braves to unprecedented heights; under
- 14 his leadership, the Braves won five National League championships and the 1995 World
- 15 Series; and
- 16 WHEREAS, under his direction, in 1980, the Braves finished fourth with their first record
- above .500 since 1974; in 1991, the Braves became one of two teams to go from last place
- 18 to first place from one year to the next; and in 1995, the Braves won the World Series
- 19 championship over the Cleveland Indians; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Mr. Cox is among the top five on the all-time major league wins list; he ranks
- 21 fourth on the Baseball All-Time Managerial Wins list with 2,504 wins, including a

franchise-record of 2,149 wins with the Atlanta Braves, which he managed to a record 14

- 23 consecutive division titles through 2005; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Mr. Cox has earned many achievements; he is a two-time World Series winning
- 25 champion and four-time recipient of Manager of the Year; he is one of only four managers
- 26 to have won the award in both the American and National league; he also the only person to
- 27 have won the award for consecutive years; Mr. Cox has also been named Manager of the
- 28 Year by *The Sporting News* eight times; and he also holds the all-time record for ejections
- 29 in Major League Baseball with 158, plus an additional three post-season ejections; and
- 30 WHEREAS, on August 12, 2011, Mr. Cox was inducted into the Atlanta Braves Hall of
- 31 Fame, and his number six jersey was retired; and
- WHEREAS, at the age of 72, Mr. Cox retired after the 2010 season, his 29th as a manager,
- 33 including 25 in two stints with the Braves.
- 34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 35 the members of this body commend Bobby Cox for being inducted into the National Baseball
- 36 Hall of Fame, invite Mr. Cox to be recognized by the House of Representatives at a date and
- 37 time designated by the Speaker of the House, and recognize Mr. Cox for his unyielding
- 38 commitment to the game of baseball.
- 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 40 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Bobby Cox.
