## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 9-15, 2020, as Georgia Court Reporting and Captioning Week at the
- 2 state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, for millennia, individuals have wanted the spoken word translated into text to
- 4 record history; to accomplish this task, they have relied on scribes; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the profession of scribe was born with the rise of civilization; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in ancient Egypt, scribes were considered to be the literate elite, recording laws
- 7 and other important documents and, since that time, have served as impartial witnesses to
- 8 history; and
- 9 WHEREAS, scribes were present with our nation's founding fathers as the Declaration of
- 10 Independence and Bill of Rights were drafted; and
- 11 WHEREAS, President Lincoln trusted scribes to record the Emancipation Proclamation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, since the advent of shorthand machines, these scribes have been known as court
- 13 reporters and have played a permanent and invaluable role in courtrooms across our country;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, court reporters are present in the Georgia General Assembly, preserving
- 16 members' words and actions; and
- 17 WHEREAS, court reporters and captioners are responsible for the closed captioning seen
- 18 scrolling across television screens, at sporting stadiums, and in other community and
- 19 educational settings, bringing information to millions of deaf and hearing-imparied
- 20 Americans every day; and

21 WHEREAS, court reporters and captioners translate the spoken work into text and preserve

- 22 our history; and
- 23 WHEREAS, whether called the scribes of yesterday or the court reporters and captioners of
- 24 today, the individuals who preserve our nation's history are truly the guardians of the record.
- 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 26 the members of the body recognize February 9-15, 2020, as Georgia Court Reporting and
- 27 Captioning Week at the state capitol.
- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 29 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 30 Georgia Shorthand Reporters Association.
