2 WHEREAS, June Wood has a long and consistent record of service to the community and
3 this state and has been recognized as one of the most dynamic and committed citizens in
4 Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, June was elected chair of the Henry County Board of Commissioners in the
6 December 6, 2016, general election run-off; and

7 WHEREAS, she spent more than 26 years with Georgia Power, retiring in 2013 as Georgia
8 Power's Metro South external affairs manager, where she served Clayton, Butts, Henry,
9 South Fulton, Fayette, and Coweta counties; and

10 WHEREAS, June was the chair of the Henry County Chamber of Commerce Board of
11 Directors, vice chair of government and education for the Henry County Chamber of
12 Commerce, and chair of the Henry County Chamber's Education Foundation; and

13 WHEREAS, she has exhibited further commitment to her community through her work as
14 the co-leader of Henry County's Economics and Education Initiative, which mobilized over
15 100 Henry County elected and appointed leaders, school system representatives, businesses,
16 and other community stakeholders to improve student academic performance and workforce
17 development; and

18 WHEREAS, June has received various accolades for her superb accomplishments, including
19 the Ed Bridges Spirit of Community Award, the Commissioner Bruce Holmes Foundation
20 Leadership Award, Georgia Power's Southern Style Excellence Award for Superior
21 Performance, and Southern Crescent Technical College President's Award of Excellence; and

22 WHEREAS, she has been featured in *Southern Journal* magazine as a Woman of Substance
23 and in *We Are Clayton* magazine for her community leadership; and

24 WHEREAS, June earned a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from the University of
25 Alabama at Birmingham and has been affiliated with multiple professional organizations,
26 including the Association of Utility Professionals, American Association of Blacks in
27 Energy, American Society of Civil Engineers, and the Georgia 100 Mentoring Program; and

28 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
29 extraordinary citizen be appropriately recognized.
