- 1 Recognizing and commending Giving Kitchen for receiving the 2019 James Beard
- 2 Humanitarian of the Year Award for its work to support and empower food service workers
- 3 in Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the James Beard Humanitarian of the Year Award is given to an individual or
- 5 organization working in the realm of food that has given selflessly and worked tirelessly to
- 6 better the lives of others and society at large; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Giving Kitchen is also the recipient of the 2019 Center for Civic Innovation
- 8 Investing in Impact Award, which recognizes individuals and organizations that fight
- 9 inequality by empowering and fighting for people and communities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Giving Kitchen grew out of a beyond-expectation response from the food
- service industry in Georgia following the devastating stage-four cancer diagnosis of Chef
- 12 Ryan Hidinger in December 2012; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Giving Kitchen is a nonprofit organization that provides assistance and stability
- 14 to food service workers through financial support, a network of community resources, and
- 15 a prioritization of self-care; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Giving Kitchen's guiding principles include empathy, generosity, community,
- 17 precision, trust, and gratitude; and
- 18 WHEREAS, since 2012, Giving Kitchen has supported more than 4,000 food service
- 19 workers in need of emergency assistance; Giving Kitchen has provided more than \$3 million
- 20 through over 2,100 awards, which has helped nearly 5,000 children and household members
- 21 of food service workers receiving assistance from Giving Kitchen; Giving Kitchen is home
- 22 to a growing community of 418,900 food service workers from throughout Georgia; and

23 WHEREAS, Giving Kitchen's awards provide financial assistance to food service workers

- based on financial need; Giving Kitchen's Stability Network is a referral program to serve
- as a connection to social services for food service workers; and

- 27 Employees (CORE), Metro Atlanta Counseling Service, Metro Atlanta American Red Cross,
- and Georgia Crisis and Access Hotline; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Giving Kitchen works to reduce the stigma surrounding mental health by
- 30 speaking openly and empathetically about suicide, substance abuse, and mental illness in the
- 31 food service industry; and
- 32 WHEREAS, annual corporate sponsors of Giving Kitchen include, but are not limited to:
- 33 Sysco, H&F Bread Co., SweetWater Brewing Co., US Foods, Ruth's Chris Steak House,
- 34 Unsukay, Creature Comforts Brewing Co., Fifth Group Restaurants, Inland Seafood, Legacy

- 36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 37 the members of this body recognize and commend Giving Kitchen for receiving the 2019
- 38 James Beard Humanitarian of the Year Award and for providing outstanding support to
