## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Trickum Middle School Robotics Team; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Trickum Middle School Robotics Team, known as the TigerBots, will travel  
3 to Houston this spring to compete in the 2022 FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of  
4 Science and Technology) Robotics World Championships, scheduled for April 20-23; and
- 5 WHEREAS, each year, FIRST introduces a research theme and presents students with a  
6 scientific, real-world challenge to address a problem and develop solutions. This year's  
7 research theme was "Cargo Connect," for which students were asked to identify a problem  
8 related to the transportation of goods or products; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the state-champion TigerBots are one of 108 teams that will be competing at  
10 the world championships; there were 24,000 teams from 50 countries in the running; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the nine-member team, which consists of 7th and 8th graders, includes Michelle  
12 Diep, Jaden Ha, Alexander Hernandez, Matthew Ionescu, Dileep Kunnath, Upasana Patel,  
13 Caleb Sutton, Justin Taylor, and Sophia Yuan, along with the team's faculty sponsor, Brian  
14 Lucy.

16 the members of this body commend the Trickum Middle School Robotics Team for their  
17 stellar academic achievements and congratulate them for being selected to compete in 2022
