## A RESOLUTION

4 to the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in  
5 a manner becoming of a Boy Scout; and

6 WHEREAS, Frank, a student at Crabapple Lane Elementary School, saved the life of one of  
7 his school mates by administering the Heimlich maneuver as the student was choking in the  
8 cafeteria; and

9 WHEREAS, this incident represented the first time in which Frank applied the Heimlich  
10 maneuver after learning it in his Boy Scout merit badge class; and

11 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man has demonstrated great leadership skills and  
12 initiative within the Boy Scouts of America program, as shown by his ability to apply the  
13 valuable skills that he has learned to his daily life; and

14 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader  
15 set an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the quick thinking and heroism of this  
17 exemplary Boy Scout be appropriately recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body honor Frank Nevarez, Jr., for saving the life of a fellow school  
20 mate.
