

House Resolution 1304

A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, except as  
3 otherwise provided in this resolution or by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly,  
4 the meeting dates, legislative days, and dates of adjournment of the 2014 regular session of  
5 the General Assembly for the period of Monday, February 10, 2014, through Tuesday,  
6 February 18, 2014, shall be as follows:

- 7 Monday, February 10 . . . . . in session for legislative day 20
- 8 Tuesday, February 11 . . . . . in session for legislative day 21
- 9 Wednesday, February 12 . . . . . in session for legislative day 22
- 10 Thursday, February 13 . . . . . in session for legislative day 23
- 11 Friday, February 14 through Monday, February 17 . . in adjournment
- 12 Tuesday, February 18 . . . . . in session for legislative day 24

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, notwithstanding the foregoing schedule of meeting  
14 dates, legislative days, and dates of adjournment, the Speaker of the House of  
15 Representatives and the President of the Senate may by concurrent agreement specify and  
16 jointly declare a revised schedule or schedules of meeting dates, legislative days, and dates  
17 of adjournment for the General Assembly during the period of Monday, February 10, 2014,  
18 through Tuesday, February 18, 2014, in which event such schedule or schedules shall stand  
19 fixed accordingly for purposes of this resolution. The Speaker of the House of  
20 Representatives and the President of the Senate need not be physically present at the capitol  
21 to make such joint declaration; however, in any event, notice of any such joint declaration  
22 shall be provided to members of the General Assembly as soon as practicable.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after February 18, 2014, the periods of  
24 adjournment of the 2014 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the  
25 General Assembly, provided that unless otherwise specified by subsequent resolution, the  
26 General Assembly shall be in adjournment on each Saturday and Sunday.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for  
28 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the  
29 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
