A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Health in Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Georgia ranked 41st among the 50 states in the United Health Foundation's
- 3 2015 Annual Report of Health Rankings; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Georgia ranked in the bottom 15 states for rate of obesity increase from
- 5 2012-2016, and an estimated \$190.2 billion is spent on obesity-related health issues annually;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, Georgia ranked in the bottom 15 states for physical inactivity, and physical
- 8 inactivity accounts for 10.8 percent of all-cause mortality, as well as low educational
- 9 attainment, socioeconomic status, violent crime, and poverty; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Georgia ranked in the bottom four states for percentage of the population with
- 11 health insurance coverage; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia ranked in the bottom four states for low infant birth weight, which is
- one of the five leading causes of United States infant mortality; and

14 WHEREAS, Georgia ranked in the bottom 14 states for deaths resulting from cardiovascular

- disease, which is the leading cause of death in the United States; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the General Assembly finds that there is a need to study the issues causing the
- 17 poor health of many citizens of Georgia and to identify policy solutions that comprehensively
- 18 address social determinants of health.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 20 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Health in Georgia.
- 22 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of seven members of the
- House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- Representatives, which shall include the Minority Leader and two other members of the
- 25 minority party. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.
- 27 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 30 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 32 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 34 (5) Allowances and funding.
- 35 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 37 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds

necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds appropriated to the House of Representatives.

(6) Report.

- (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
 - (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee. A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with

the Clerk of the House of Representatives.

- 53 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the 54 House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu 55 thereof.
- 56 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2021.
