A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 15, 2021, as Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. Day at the state capitol;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. was founded at Howard University in
4 Washington, D.C., on January 15, 1908, and has the distinction of being the first sorority
5 established by African American college women for African American college women; and

6 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. has expanded to more than 1,018 chapters
7 world-wide, with Georgia serving as host to approximately 50 of those chapters on college
8 and university campuses, and numerous active alumnae groups throughout communities
9 around the state; and

10 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority is committed to community service and actively
11 contributes to the educational, civic, health, and socioeconomic life of Georgia's citizens; and

12 WHEREAS, alumnae chapters are encouraging their members to become involved
13 community volunteers and community advocates, and their primary service components

14 include HCBU for Life: A Call to Action; Women's Healthcare and Wellness; Building Your
15 Economic Legacy; The Arts!; and Global Impact; and

16 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Inc. Day at the state capitol is an international program
17 developed for members of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority to meet with their legislators and to
18 discuss issues that are pertinent to strengthening families and communities; and

19 WHEREAS, at the direction of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc.'s International President
20 Dr. Glenda Baskin Glover and International Connection Chairperson Roslyn Brock, South
21 Atlantic Region Director Carolyn G. Randolph, Georgia Connection Coordinator the
22 Honorable Karen Bennett, Georgia Connection Liaison the Honorable Carolyn Hugley, and
23 the Honorable Dar'shun Kendrick have convened this delegation for the purpose of civic
24 engagement and community involvement, exemplifying the motto "Amplifying Our Voice
25 and Mobilizing for Change as AKAs L.E.A.D. (Learn, Empower, Advocate, and Decide)."

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
27 the members of this body recognize February 15, 2021, as Alpha Kappa Alpha Inc. Day at
28 the state capitol.
