A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Douglas "Doug" H. Garrison and dedicating an intersection in his
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
4 with the passing of Mr. Douglas "Doug" H. Garrison on August 2, 2022; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Garrison graduated from the University of Georgia with a master's degree
6 in horticulture in 1971; and

7 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
8 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
9 dramatically by his superlative service with the County Extension Service, beginning with
10 Elbert County and later transferring to Barrow County; and

11 WHEREAS, his leadership was instrumental to numerous organizations, including the
12 Barrow County Board of Education, Barrow County Board of Commissioners, the Rotary
13 Club, and Walton-Barrow Board of Realtors; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Garrison established the Barrow County Cattleman's Association and
15 served as president of the Barrow County Farm Bureau; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
17 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 316 and State Route 53 in
20 Barrow County is dedicated as the Douglas "Doug" H. Garrison Memorial Interchange.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
22 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Douglas "Doug" H. Garrison
23 Memorial Interchange.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
25 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
26 family of Mr. Douglas "Doug" H. Garrison and to the Department of Transportation.
