9 Dream every summer; and

12 WHEREAS, Camp Dream has a one-to-one camper to counselor ratio, which not many13 camps in the country are able to boast; and

WHEREAS, summer camp sessions are 100 percent volunteer driven at Camp Dream, and
Camp Directors, Counselors, and camp staff are all volunteers, with many taking vacation
time from their jobs to operate the camp.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
the members of this body commend Camp Dream on their 20th anniversary, recognize
February 25, 2015, as Camp Dream Day, and invite representatives of the camp to be
recognized by the House of Representatives at a date and time designated by the Speaker of
