A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mr. Richard "Ricky" Alan Dykes and dedicating an intersection in his honor;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Richard "Ricky" Alan Dykes was born on August 10, 1954, in
4 Hawkinsville, Georgia, and graduated from Cochran High School; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Dykes worked loading hay for erosion control and learned every aspect of
6 the road-building industry during his first job with the family owned Everett Dykes Grassing
7 Company; and

8 WHEREAS, he has served in numerous capacities for the company over the years and
9 continues to provide leadership and support as a consultant and advisor; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Dykes' expertise and leadership have been invaluable to the Georgia
11 Highway Contractors Association, where he has served on the board of directors and as
12 president; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
14 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in his honor.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
16 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 112 and Abney
17 Road/Willis-Howell Road in Bleckley County is dedicated as the Ricky Dykes Intersection.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
19 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Ricky Dykes Intersection.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
21 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mr.
22 Richard "Ricky" Alan Dykes and to the Department of Transportation.
