A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Wesley Frank Weaver and dedicating a mile of road in his memory;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
4 with the passing of Mr. Wesley Frank Weaver on January 22, 2019; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Weaver was born on July 20, 1941, in Buena Vista, Georgia, and was
6 united in love and marriage for 54 wonderful years to Barbara Weaver; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Weaver came from humble beginnings to become a community leader and
8 successful businessman; and

9 WHEREAS, he was the owner of Oakcrest Lumber, which was his passion in life; and

10 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
11 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
12 family and friends were admired by others; and

13 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Weaver was an active member of River
14 of Life Church; and

15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
17 made this world a better place in which to live; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
19 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a mile of road in his memory.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 41 from mile marker 6 to mile
22 marker 7 in Marion County, Georgia, is dedicated as the Wesley Frank Weaver Memorial
23 Mile.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
25 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Wesley Frank Weaver
26 Memorial Mile.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
28 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
29 family of Mr. Wesley Frank Weaver and to the Department of Transportation.
